Snow sports – social environment and integration. <p>It is up to the Interski Board to select the lecturers.</p> <p>On Monday, Wednesday and Thursday there will be two lectures of 30 minutes each, depending on the number of member countries submitting papers. Abstracts of the presentations must be sent to the Interski Office by 30 June 2010.</p> <p>For the on-snow workshops, member countries are to choose one of the four topics above and deal with it during their workshops. A summary will be made in the afternoon (internally) and a message on the respective topic will be released during the evening show.</p> <p>The order in which the key lectures are delivered will be determined after the abstracts have been received.</p>
