1. Park + Pipe

The Technical Board of the ISIA has proposed to take as a subject the possibilities for the gliding devices in the different terrain forms, to be able to compose a survey of the movements in the matter. At the ISIA Event 2000 the Halfpipe + Kiker (jumping) will be chosen as the form of the terrain. Every nation is asked to perform 4 different possibilities of movement for the different gliding devices (from easy to difficult shows).

Every nation is asked to name the chosen movements, to describe them briefly and to give their function on a DIN A-4 page.

2. Methodology

Common methodological procedure in skiing, snowboard and other devices

At the Interski-Congress in Beitostolen, Switzerland has presented a proposition for a common methodological procedure in the gliding disciplines. It was said that some nations worked also with the same ideas on the development of new teaching programmes. To actualise this question, the subject "Common methodological possibilities for gliding devices" will be treated at the Event mentioned before. Every participating nation should demonstrate in about 15 minutes a short view of the methodological procedure on snow and should explain in a short paper (1 DIN A-4 page) the correspondent intention.

As a result of the presentations of these written propositions a correspondent brochure will be drawn up.

Every participating nation is urgently asked to make some reflections on the proposed subject and to organise an appropriate demonstration.

The success of the Event can only be assured thanks to a correspondent participation.

3. Theory

a) Structure of the training

Every participating nation (even if it does not demonstrate in the practical part) is asked to bring along a survey of the structure of the training (1 or 2 pages) and to explain the structure with the help of films/foils.

b) Structure of the teaching programme

The result of the ISIA-Event should be a survey on the structure of the training programmes that are used in the nations. The nations are asked to present a survey on the structure of the training programme (1 page) and to explain it at the Event.

c) Material of teaching

Every nation is asked to bring along material of teaching and publicity of the associations (videos, posters, books etc.), to describe briefly the single materials on 1 page and to give the reference address.

A brochure will be made of all the written papers, which will be sent to the nations. That's why it is so important that the correspondent propositions will be made and presented at the ISIA-Event.

To be able to organise well the event, we ask the nations that want to take part in it, to tell the ISIA who wants to present a practical demonstration in Park + Pipe and in the methodology, as told in the announcement.

It would also be important to know the provisional number of the participants and the devices the participants will use. We ask you to send back, please, to the ISIA the enclosed form.
